



ARE YOU USING AN ELECTRONIC HEALTH RECORD (EHR)??

If you are not using an electronic health record (EHR), you could be in for some major payment reductions in the upcoming years. Eligible Professionals (EPs) who do not successfully demonstrate meaningful use (MU) of certified EHR technology, will see a payment adjustment in their Medicare physician fee schedule amount for covered professional services.

The payment adjustments are scheduled as follows:

- 2015 – 1% payment reduction of Medicare physician fee schedule covered amount
- 2016 – 2% payment reduction of Medicare physician fee schedule covered amount
- ≥ 2017 – 3% payment reduction of Medicare physician fee schedule covered amount

If it is determined that for 2018 and subsequent years that less than 75% of EPs are meaningful users then the payment adjustment will change by one percentage point each year until the payment reduction reaches 95%.

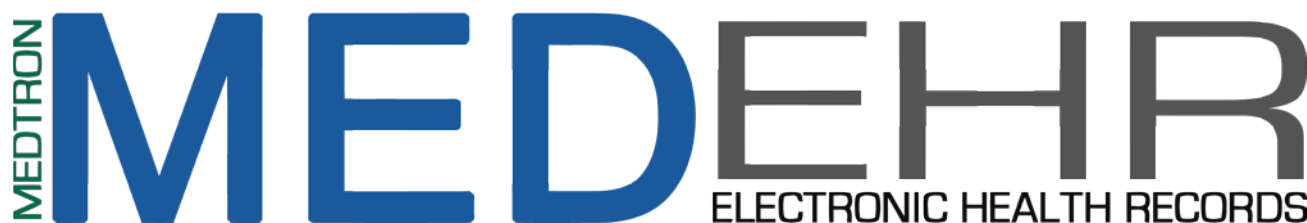
