



MEDICARE REMIT EASY PRINT (MREP) - VERSION 4.2 IS NOW AVAILABLE!

The Centers for Medicare & Medicaid Services (CMS) developed Medicare Remit Easy Print (MREP) software as a tool providers can use to read and print a remittance advice (RA) in a familiar readable format.

Providers who use the MREP software package can print paper documentation, i.e., a remit, that can be used to reconcile their MEDTRON (MSI) unprocessed batches to the ERA records/files; and create document(s)/EOBs which can be attached to secondary Coordination of Benefits (COB) payer claims.

NOTE: An MREP is only available for records received via ERA. Refer to **User Guide: Medicare Easy Remit Print (MREP)** for further instructions.

The MREP software is available *free* through CMS and includes the updated Claim Adjustment Reason Codes (CARC)/ Remittance Advice Remark Codes (RARC) file.
